




TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATIONS:

THE MOST GLAMOROUS SHIP ON THE SEAS

- Origin: Genoa, Italy
- Named for: Admiral Giovanni Andrea Doria (b. 1539, d. 1606), Admiral of the Genoese Fleet who helped establish Genoa as a sea power, repelling the French, the Turks, the Spanish, and an onslaught of pirates in the 15th Century, frequently changing his allegiances to take advantage of the fortunes of war.
- Christened: June 16, 1951 by Cardinal Giuseppe Siri, Archbishop of Genoa
- Completed: December 1952
- Maiden voyage: 1953
- Final voyage: 1956 (101st Atlantic crossing)

SPECIFICATIONS:

- 697-feet long
- 29,100 tons
- Twin, sixteen-foot diameter bronze screws, driven by steam turbines capable of attaining 5,000 horsepower, propelled the Doria through water
